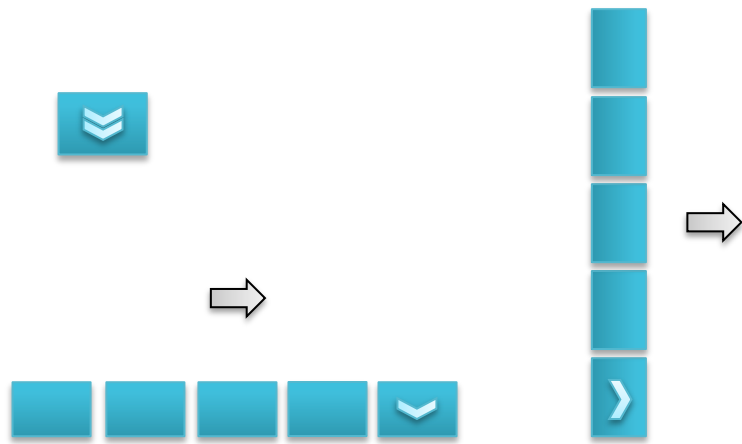

Section 12: Section Drill

35.0 On the Right (Left) Form Section



35.1 This movement is carried out when a Section, marching in single rank, changes formation without changing direction.

35.2 The movement may be carried out from the halt to the halt; from the halt to the move; on the move; or from the move to the halt

In the following flowchart of the form orders are in separate sections because each section provides different details of the formation to the cadets about to execute the form. The parts of the order in red are not to be said, the cadets can infer what movement they are meant to perform with or without the red text being said.

Part one of the order identifies who you are talking to, also your section is given warning that there is about to be an order given. Part two provides details of how they will end in the formation, if the order results with them 'on the move' then you don't say anything. Part three identifies what type of for they will be performing along with direction. And lastly, part four and five is the executive order in which the cadets will act.
