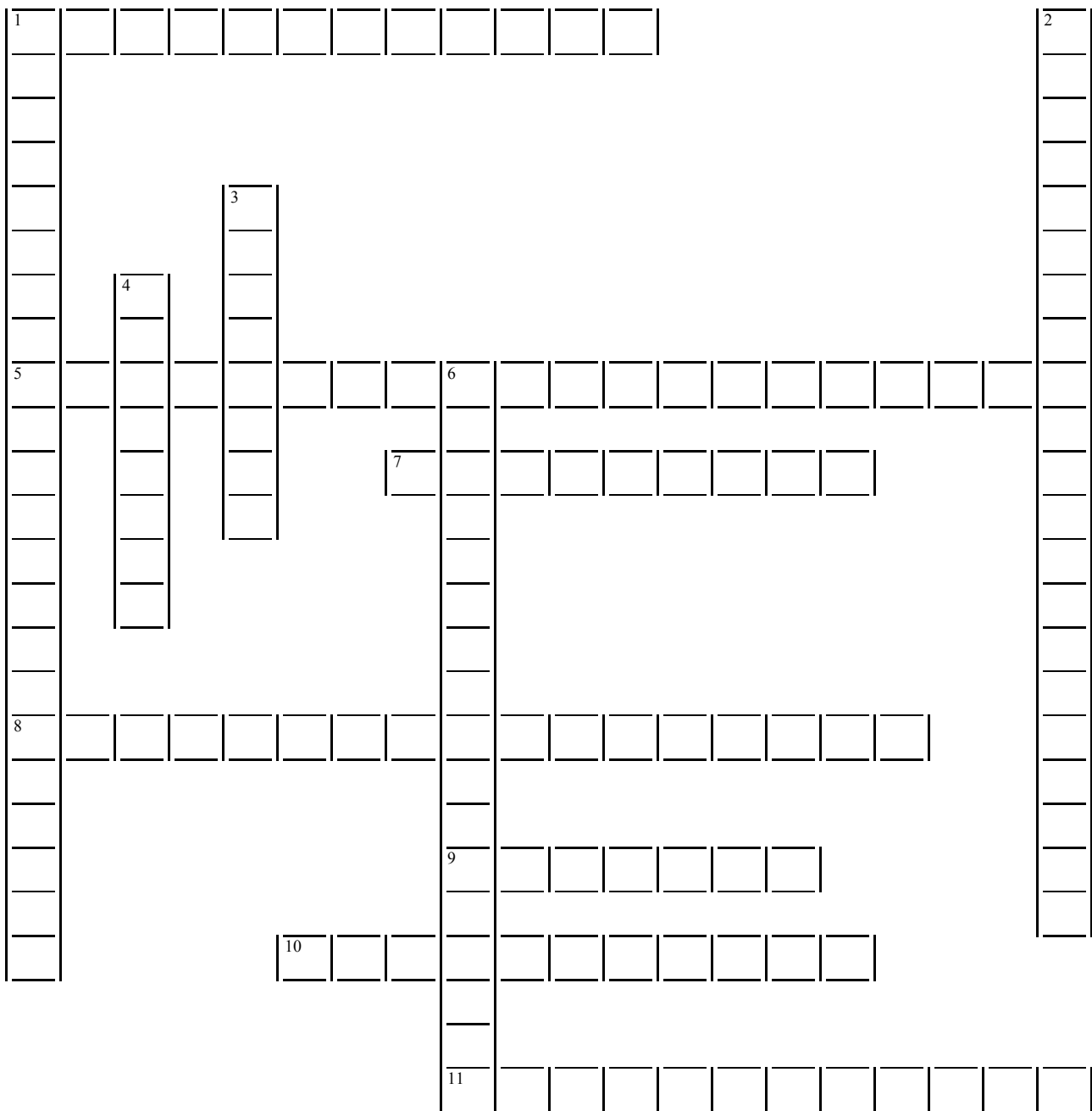


Photography: Sections Five and Six



ACROSS

- 1 The portion of an image that is in focus or is sharp, the focus point, a picture with only a portion in focus has a low f number, such as f2 or f2.8 (p13)
- 5 Ring which selects the aperture's fnumber (p13)
- 7 Critical function for taking quality pictures, adjusting the camera to make the subject sharp (p13)
- 8 These are examples of what? 1\500, 1\1000, 1\2000 (p12)
- 9 Controls the amount of light that reaches the film (p12)
- 10 Having a fast shutter speed like 1\500 will eliminate this (p12)
- 11 Controls the time in which the shutter remains open (p12)

DOWN

- 1 When looking through the viewfinder there are two images that come together to help get the subject in focus (p13)
- 2 Centre of the image in the viewfinder is split in two, when focused the two images are brought together (p13)
- 3 Is the hole in which light enters the camera, also called a iris like in your eye (p13)
- 4 The shutter remains open as long as the shutter button is pressed down (p12)
