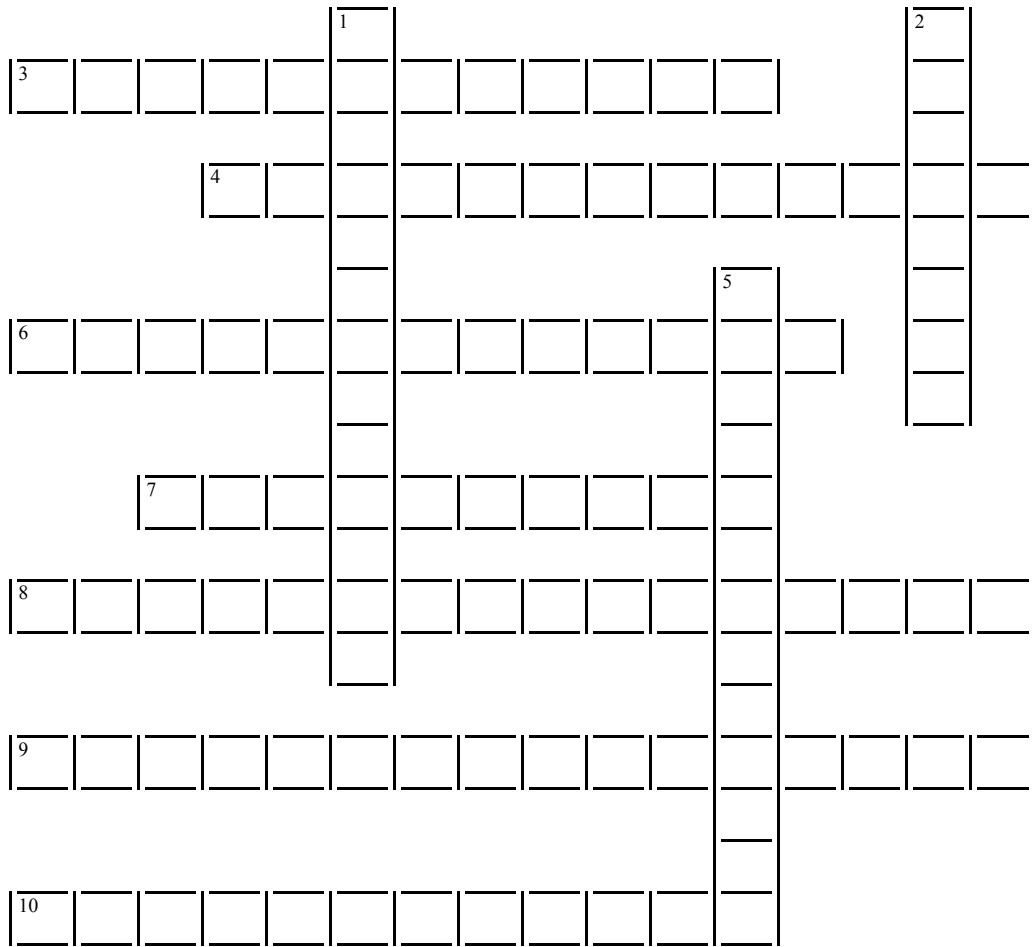


# Photography: Sections One and Two



## ACROSS

- 3 Louis Daguerre's invention also called "mirror with a memory" (p3)
- 4 This happens when a camera has a separate viewing system for the taker. One viewing system for the subject and one for the exposing for the film (p6)
- 6 Half pressure locks the focus when full pressure takes the picture (p7)
- 7 Lens coatings improve the lens quality and cut down random light that can spoil the picture (p7)
- 8 He is often considered considered the father of modern photography (p3)
- 9 This is a camera that has a good use in outside shots and taking pictures of moving objects or rapid shots (p5)
- 10 He produced the first ever permanent photograph, exposure time was 8 hours (p3)
